Dr. Marvin J. Robb Memorial Scholarship**

MISSION: Tuality Healthcare Foundation supports OHSU Tuality Healthcare by funding projects and programs that enrich the patient experience and wellness of our community.

SCHOLARSHIP FUNDING: The Tuality Healthcare Foundation Scholarship Committee is authorized to award cash grants to area high school seniors pursuing a human healthcare related career.

Upon her retirement in 1992, the Flo Rhea Health Careers Endowment Scholarship was established to pay tribute to Flo's 12 years of service to Tuality Healthcare. Funds were raised for this endowed scholarship amongst Flo's family and friends. This scholarship is a reminder of Flo's outstanding inspiration, values, and commitment to the future of healthcare by investing in the young people of our community. **The Flo Rhea Health Careers Endowment Scholarship will award one (1) \$1,700 scholarship to a student pursuing a career in a human healthcare related field. The scholarship is to be used during the 2020-2021 school year at a 2 or 4 year college or vocational school.**

Dr. Marvin J. Robb practiced medicine at Tuality Community Hospital for 38 years and retired in 1983. In 2007, Marlys Carter, a Tuality Healthcare Foundation Board Member, established the Dr. Marvin J. Robb Memorial Scholarship in honor of Dr. Robb's many years of service to the community. **The Dr. Marvin J. Robb Memorial Scholarship will award one (1) \$2,700 scholarship to a student pursuing a career in a human healthcare related field. The scholarship is to be used during the 2020-2021 school year at a 2 or 4 year college or vocational school.**

ELIGIBILITY & SELECTION CRITERIA Each applicant must be a current graduating high school senior attending one of the following schools: Aloha, Banks, Century, Faith Bible Christian, Forest Grove, Gaston, Glencoe, Hillsboro, Hillsboro Online Academy, Liberty, Life Christian, Miller Education Center or Westview. Selection criteria will be based on the following:

- Applicant must be pursuing a career in a human healthcare related field
- Applicant must have a cumulative unweighted GPA of 3.5 or higher
- Applicant must have an SAT score of 1000 or ACT score of 19 or higher. Test scores must be sent by the school. **Screenshots or printouts from a student's testing account will not be accepted.**
- Specific classes relating to goal
- Specific goal within a human healthcare related career
- Extracurricular activities (especially those relating to goal)

APPLICATION PROCESS:

1. Applicants should complete the online scholarship application. A link to the online application can also be found on the Tuality Healthcare Foundation website at tualityfoundation.org.
2. Once the online application has been completed, applicants will email a current transcript, test scores, and one letter of recommendation to melanie.johnson@tuality.org or faxed to (503) 681-1942 by **noon on April 3, 2020**. Late or incomplete applications will not be accepted. Letter of recommendation must be included in the same email containing the transcript and test scores and may not be sent separately. Please call 503-681-1285 with any questions.
3. If selected for an interview, the applicant will be contacted on or around April 13, 2020. Interviews will be held on Monday, April 20, 2020 from 5:30 pm – 8:30 pm. **This is the only date and time offered. In order to qualify for the scholarship, the applicant must be able to interview in person on the evening of April 20. Phone or Skype interviews will not be offered or considered.**
4. Scholarship awards will be presented to the recipient at their school's annual award assembly.
